The next trend-The Internet of Behavior

Technology is evolving at a lightning-fast pace, leading to the emergence of new communication protocols such as the Internet of Behavior (IoB). IoB offers an innovative way of monitoring, controlling, and modelling human behaviour. It is a system that employs sensors and other advanced technologies to observe, analyse, and predict human behaviour.

loB encompasses various cutting-edge technologies such as artificial intelligence (AI), machine learning (ML), big data analytics, cloud computing, Internet of Things (IoT) devices, mobile applications, wearable devices, augmented reality (AR), virtual reality (VR), robotics automation systems, and more.
